**1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received from Cllrs Smith and Botting. Cllr Cary also apologised – he would attend but would be late.

**2. AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PUBLIC TO ADDRESS THE TOWN COUNCIL**

Two members of the public were present - Mr Greaves and Mr McKinder from Station Road, Market Weighton. Both residents were concerned about the possibility of a walker's car park being put in after the spill well work was completed as it had been promised that the area would be reinstated after the work was finished. The Chairman explained about the car park being needed to encourage walkers to use this area so as to free spaces up in the Market Car Park. The Town Council had previously looked at funding for this in the past but it had been part of the negotiations when it was found out that the spillway was being done. The area to be used as car park after the work was completed was the compound that the contractors would use for their equipment. A planning application would of course have to be put in and at that point residents would have the opportunity to put in their objections. Other Councillors also stated that it had always been an intention to put a car park in that area and that any misuse of the car park could be reported to the police. There was further general discussion by all before the residents left the meeting.

It was proposed by Cllr Rudd and seconded by Cllr Townshend that the previous Minutes be signed as a true and correct record. AGREED. Short discussion on reporting on the minutes. Request for special meetings to go on next agenda so they can be approved.

**Folio 6464** – Ernllca have advised that the item ‘to note dispensations given to any member of the council in respect of the agenda items listed below’ be put on all agendas. Councillors asked this to be an agenda item for the next meeting.

**Folio 6471** – Xmas Card collection from Councillors was £35 which was the sum of £17.50 for each of the Mayor’s Charities.

*Clerk Magazine –are asking for contributions from smaller councils. The deadline is 25<sup>th</sup> January for March edition.*

Councillor asked if there had been any movement on the hire of top floor. Clerk stated had not heard official position from ERNLLCA yet. A Councillor stated that the group thinking of hiring the top floor had actually moved from Driffield to join another group at Howden. The Clerk was asked to look in the PLWB file to see if there was a restriction on sub letting.

A Councillor asked if there had been any movement on the 6<sup>th</sup> form closure. The Clerk confirmed no reply to letter to ERYC as yet. The Clerk was asked to phone the school to see a representative would attend the meeting on the 6<sup>th</sup> February.

#### **6. TO FINALIZE PRECEPT FOR 2013 - 2014**

The Chairman asked that £500 be made available to support the Kiplingcotes Derby due to the problems of running the Derby in the future without funding. (The Clerk confirmed this could be vied across from the TCCF without affecting the budget). AGREED. The Chairman explained that if MWTC requested the amount they did last year the council tax would go up to residents. However as funding was available to support Parish and Town Councils this could be offset against the amount we ask for which means residents would pay the same as last year. AGREED.

#### **7. TO DISCUSS THE MARKET WEIGHTON TOWN COUNCILS GRITTING POLICY**

The Community Emergency Plan was passed to the Chairman. This gave the current primary, secondary and tertiary routes for gritting by the Handyman during bad weather. After discussion it was AGREED that it was too late for this winter to have an additional workable policy but that the Handyman would continue as he has been doing under instruction from the Town Clerk. It was thought that for next year Councillors could put in information about vulnerable areas and these could be put on a list to be done after the areas on the emergency plan. The Clerk was asked to ensure that bins were not overfilled as lids that did not close properly were causing the grit to become solid. There was also a discussion regarding additional bins but no decision was made. The Clerk stated that many residents had been informed that MWTC were responsible for gritting the area by ERYC and had written to ERYC regarding this matter.

#### **8. TO CONSIDER POSSIBILITY OF A LITTER BIN ON HILL RISE**

A Councillor had checked the Hill Rise area and there appeared to be no waste bins in the Hill Rise/Hill Drive area. A resident had offered to have the bin outside his house. Another Councillor had also noticed rubbish left on seating outside the Tesco entrance on Sancton Road. After discussion Cllr Rudd proposed and Cllr King seconded that the Clerk look into getting a bin placed in both these areas and if possible have a MWTC logo put on them. AGREED.

There was also mention of an ITV programme - Thursday evenings about nurses in the community. Opening credits include shots of Hagstons Butchers and the Curio Shop next to it - the second episode to include the area around Market Weighton.

**Cllr Curwen** –Mentioned that the Tigers Takeaway sign that should have come down on the 7<sup>th</sup> January was still up - Town Clerk asked to mention this to the enforcement officer. Also mentioned the notice on the Scout Hut sign – Town Clerk to look into whether this could be removed. Also reported the newsletter delivery area -Town Clerk to speak to Boys Brigade leader. Also reported entrance to Town Council car park having several potholes – Town Clerk to have a word with handyman or report to ERYC.

**Cllr Hemmerman** – Discussed parking on verges on Langdale Road – this is still happening despite notices having been issued by ERYC - the area looks very messy. Town Clerk asked to contact John Skidmore at ERYC. Also mentioned - pot holes on Southgate (including a new area done) between the dentist and the sweetshop - Town Clerk to report.
