



HOLME ROAD CEMETERY FEES - 1st APRIL 2020 / 2021

Following the death of someone, and it is the wish of the family for them to be buried in the Holme Road Cemetery; the Funeral Director will contact the Town Council. If a burial plot has been reserved, staff will alert the Cemetery Caretaker to the date of the ceremony and the grave is prepared. If the family has not reserved a burial plot, the Town Clerk in consultation with the Cemetery Caretaker will allocate one.

FOR ANY INTERMENTS IN A GRAVE OR VAULT

The body of: A person whose age exceeds 16 years - resident	£293.00
A person whose age exceeds 16 years - non-resident	£578.00
<i>The above fees apply where interment is at a depth not exceeding 5 feet</i>	

CREMATED REMAINS

For the interment of cremated remains in a family grave	£83.00
For the interment of cremated remains - resident	£125.00
For the interment of cremated remains - non-resident	£249.00

EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL (including Registration Fee)

For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave 8ft x 4ft - resident	£293.00
For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave 8ft x 4ft - non-resident	£578.00

GRAVEDIGGER

Charge for each grave dug and subsequent turfing to the grave	£293.00
Charge for the interment of cremated remains (new plot)	£125.00
Charge for the interment of cremated remains in a family grave	£42.00
(Gravedigger charges are for both resident and non resident)	

MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND INSCRIPTIONS

<u>A Flat Stone</u> Not exceeding 8ft x 4ft	£122.00
<u>A Head Stone</u> Not exceeding 2ft in height	£56.00
Exceeding 2ft but not exceeding 4ft in height	£73.00
Exceeding 4ft in height – for each extra 6 inches	£42.00
<u>A Foot Stone</u> Not exceeding 18 inches in height	£56.00
Exceeding 18 inches – for each extra 6 inches	£42.00
<u>Kerb Stones</u> Not exceeding 8ft x 4ft	£122.00
<u>A Monument in any other form</u>	
Not exceeding 8ft x 4ft in area or 7ft in height	£430.00
Exceeding 7ft in height	£833.00
Any Inscription after the first on a gravestone or monument	£27.00

FOR THE RIGHT TO PLACE ON ANY GRAVE

A monument in the form of a stone vase with inscription	£34.00
A table with inscription	£34.00



Families wishing to erect a monument or a headstone have to submit their design to the Town Clerk for approval via either their Funeral Director or a Stone Mason. If the Town Clerk feels that the design or wording is unsuitable, he or she will apply to the Town Council for a decision.

The Holme Road Cemetery is open daily and visitors are asked to respect the need for peace and tranquillity. Grave spaces are sold to families in perpetuity. Maintenance of monuments is the responsibility of the families who erect them and not the Town Council. Headstone Safety Checks will take place and if any Headstone deemed to be dangerous the Town Clerk will contact the family. If no contact can be made then the headstone will be safely laid flat. Every reasonable effort is made to ensure the security of the Cemetery, no responsibility can be accepted by the Town Council for damage to graves and memorials.

Fees are reviewed on an Annual basis and the new rates come into force on 1st April
