#### **Conditions of Entry.**

1. Open to all artists resident in the East Riding of Yorkshire.
2. Each artist may submit TWO PIECES OF WORK in any medium, two or three dimensional.
3. Photographs or prints will not be accepted in this exhibition.
4. All two dimensional work must be framed or on a stretched canvas and have a hanging chord stretched tight approximately one third of the way from the top of the work. Work without the required hanging chord as described will not be accepted. As hanging space is limited priority will be given to two dimensional works less than 1 metre in any dimension. If you have any doubts or queries about the eligibility of your work please contact the Council on 01430 871430 before submitting your entry.
5. Please attach two labels to your work giving the artists name, title, medium and price. One label to be taped flat to the rear of the work, the second to be securely attached to a piece of string and left hanging slightly below. Work without labels will not be accepted.
6. All entries must be the artist's own original work and not a copy of work by any other artist.
7. A non-returnable fee of **£2 per artwork** to cover administration costs will be charged at submission whether or not your work is accepted.
8. All works should be for sale and you will be appointing Market Weighton Town Council as your agent. The work will be sold at the price stated on your entry form **less a commission of 20%** retained by the Council. Work will be exhibited throughout the exhibition period and sold items collected at the end of the exhibition. Payment for sales will be paid to the artist within 30 days of the close of the exhibition providing payment has been received from the purchaser.  
  
Unsold items should be collected within 10 days of the close of the exhibition or the Council reserve the right to dispose of them for charitable purposes.
9. Appointed judges will select the works for exhibition. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
10. **Market Weighton Town Council can accept no liability for loss or damage to works submitted to the exhibition. Our organisers and staff will take every care to protect work submitted but you are advised to arrange your own insurance for your artwork.**
